SEALANTS

At our clinic we focus on preventative dentistry. The most common areas for children to develop tooth decay are the pits and grooves of the teeth. These pits and grooves are large enough for bacteria and carbohydrates to enter, but too narrow for the toothbrush to clean.

A sealant is a bonded resin that seals the pits and grooves to keep bacteria and carbohydrates out. This helps to prevent cavities. Sealants are tooth colored and are easily placed without the need for injections of anesthesia. This is a very cost effective procedure that is covered by most types of insurance.

Signing below gives your permission to place sealants where the doctor prescribes them, if they are covered by your insurance.
